

Wicoicage Sakowin kin un Wicakagapi

A program to build a sustainable service delivery model for offering financial literacy and entrepreneurship education and internship opportunities that build long-term employment and life skills of youth.

Four Bands provides **curriculum, training, and coaching** to teachers from the elementary, middle, junior high, and high school grade levels at the K-12 school systems on the Reservation to enable financial literacy and entrepreneurship education to be integrated into existing classes.

Paid youth entrepreneur internships that high school age youths help create for themselves at a business or nonprofit organization. Four Bands requires youths to put half of their earnings into an Individual Development Account (IDA) savings program that is matched 1:1 by the project to support a future asset-producing goal—further education, a business enterprise, or the purchase of a home.

Youth IDA savings program where high school age youths provide their own source of earned income and earn a 1:1 match on their savings.
