### **C.R.E.A.T.E. (Cheyenne River Entrepreneurial Assistance Training and Education)**

Create your future! Start a new business or expand an existing one through participation in C.R.E.A.T.E. Our business development class will provide you with tools for personal and business financial record keeping, plus research and planning tips for developing your own business plan. You'll benefit from business success coaching helping you identify and implement strategies to grow your business. Talking Circles – classes and workshops offered in partnership with the Cheyenne River Chamber of Commerce – are also offered to promote an exchange of ideas among business owners and expand the capacity of the business community. And as an added bonus, you'll be eligible to apply for a small business loan through Four Bands Community Fund, upon successful completion of the program.

### **Mazaska K'sapa Nitawa – Your Money Wisdom**

Mazaska K'sapa Nitawa – Your Money Wisdom - allows you to build assets through participation in financial literacy classes, Credit Builder microloans (up to \$3,000), and a savings match program. ### **Revolving Loan Fund**

Create your own job! Expand your current business! Four Bands' revolving loan fund supports private business startup as well as business expansion. To qualify, you must reside on Reservation, operate your business within the Reservation boundaries, and be either a member of the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe or a permanent resident of the Reservation. We have two loan products to suit your needs: Microloans - up to \$10,000; and Small Business Loans - \$10,000 to \$150,000.

Our children are our future! The Wicoicage Sakowin kin un Wicakagapi - Building for the Seventh Generation program is designed to provide long-term employment and life skills to area youth by offering financial literacy and entrepreneurship education, as well as internship opportunities. And they'll learn how to be fiscally responsible through financial literacy classes, part of an initiative we launched to integrate personal finance and entrepreneurship education into area K-12 schools.
